



2013 WOMEN IN DEFENSE – CHESAPEAKE BAY CHAPTER

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Through the HORIZONS Scholarship, Women In Defense (WID), a national security organization, encourages women to pursue careers related to the national security and defense interests of the United States and to provide development opportunities to women already working in national security and defense fields. The scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to further educational objectives of women who are US citizens either employed or planning careers in defense or national security areas.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible applicants will be limited to those individuals meeting the following criteria:

- Must be US Citizens
- Must reside in either St. Mary's, Charles, or Calvert County
- Must be female and demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career related to national security or defense
- Must be currently enrolled at an accredited university or college, either part-time or full-time. Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible; undergraduates must have attained at least junior level status (60 credits), with a GPA of at least 3.25.

No person, or any member of his or her immediate family, who is connected with the selection of the scholarship recipient shall be eligible to receive the award.

The WID Scholarship Committee is the sole and final authority in determining the recipients of the scholarship awards.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Scholarships of up to \$1,000 will be awarded. The winner(s) will receive a check made out to the institution of learning that the student will attend in the fall. The award will be used to offset the cost of tuition.

OBLIGATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP WINNER

The Scholarship Chairperson, Christine Chase, is to be informed by the recipient, in writing, of any changes in college planning, permanent address, or if the recipient terminates studies for any reason. If the recipient terminates studies and there are remaining funds, the institution will retain funds for award to another student of their choice following the above eligibility guidelines. The Chairperson for the Scholarship of the WID – Chesapeake Bay Chapter is to be informed if the recipient is unable to enroll in college or if their ability to attend is interrupted or delayed because of prolonged illness or injury. In these cases the award will be held in reserve. The advice of the college medical service or the attending physician will be considered in determining the length of time the award will be held.

APPLYING FOR THE 2013 SCHOLARSHIP

1. Complete attached application.
2. Prepare and submit a 500-word essay on why you believe you deserve this scholarship, AND how it will aid you in the pursuit of your career aspiration to join the national security or defense industry.
3. Most current/relevant **official** academic transcript.
4. Two letters of recommendations from individuals who are familiar with your accomplishments and career goals. At least one (1) recommendation must be from a major advisor or faculty member.
5. Entire application package (items 1-4 above) must be mailed in ONE envelope to:
